The Goulburn Art Award has been running since 1992 and is open to professional artists who live within a 120km radius of Goulburn. The award is designed to support artistic practices in the region and present the diversity and vibrancy of those practices to our audience. The award is open to works in any medium and in 2018 will be judged by David Broker, Director, Canberra Contemporary Art Space.

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Goulburn Art Award is open to artists living within a 120 radius of Goulburn CBD.
2. The Young Artist Award is open to year 10, 11 and 12 students who attend a high school within a 120km radius of Goulburn CBD.
3. A non-refundable entry fee of \$25.00 applies. A receipt will be issued for tax purposes. Payment can be made via credit card, eftpos, cash or cheque.
4. No entry fee applies to the Young Artist Award.
5. All entered artwork must have been completed after April 2017 and be the original work of the artist.
6. The entry fee, signed entry form, images, CV and statement must be received by the gallery in one email or package by **12pm Thursday, 15 March 2018.**
7. Only one work can be submitted for consideration, which is to be specified on the entry form.
8. Up to five images can be submitted to support the entry and to give context to entrant's artistic practice.
9. Image files must be high resolution jpegs and the file name must correspond to the artwork being submitted to the award.
10. The images supplied must be high resolution, suitable for print and online but no larger than 8 megabytes in total.
11. Due to space limitations, only finalists will be hung in the exhibition.
12. Two dimensional works must be no larger than 200 x 200cm including framing, and be fitted with two D rings, or other suitable hanging device.
13. Three dimensional work must not exceed a volume of more than 100cm cubed and must not exceed more than 200cm in one direction
14. Any work must not exceed 50 kilograms in weight.
15. Time based works must be submitted on a USB, or a link provided to view the entire work.
16. Artworks that are not archival in nature will be assessed in addition to their suitability for display in a museum environment (i.e. exposed botanical elements or untreated timbers).
17. The work must be available to exhibit from **20 April – 28 April 2018.**
18. If selected as a finalist, work must be delivered to the Gallery during opening hours Mon – Fri 9am – 5pm **9 April - 13 April 2018.**
19. Work must be labelled with artists name, title, year, medium and dimensions.
20. Work must be accompanied with installation instructions and all equipment necessary to display the work.
21. If a finalist, work must be collected from the Gallery during opening hours Mon – Fri 9am – 5pm **1 May – 4 May 2018**
22. Winner will be contracted, as relevant, by the Gallery to fulfil their prize. A copy of the contract can be provided upon request.

#### GOT QUESTIONS?

The Gallery is running two events to support artists in the lead up to the Award: An open day on Monday, 12 February where you can discuss the application process for the Award one on one with a Gallery staff member, and a group workshop on documenting artwork on Wednesday, 14 February. Both these events are free so phone or email the gallery to book your spot.
