Thank you said the master Thank you said the dame And thank you said the little boy/girl Who lived down the lane


SHOW ME A LINE







String Art

Here is a drawing titled 'unfinished thought' by Ashleigh Deaton, Young Artist Award winner in 2020 Goulburn Art Awards.

We are gong to make a similar piece of art but instead of a single line contour drawing, we are going to use a piece of wool and foil.

You will need:

- A piece of cardboard
 - Some wool
- Aluminium foil (check with mum or dad before using all the kitchen foil)
 - Glue
 - Textas



1) Draw an outline of your picture or draw a twisty line on your cardboard

- 2) Glue wool on outline
- 3) Cover with foil and carefully smooth around the wool

4) You can leave your work finished here or you can colour your string art
