Then home he will go


And laugh, "Ho, Ho, Ho !

Something to MAKE

FROST PERSON COLLAGE

It's been getting a little bit nippy outside with frost on the ground. Have you seen Jack Frost jumping around leaving silvery ice on the grass?

We are going to use our imaginations to create a collage of Frost People or of some of the frost spread everywhere.



You will need:

- * Blue and White Paper

I used tissue paper and cellophane, if you don't have any blue paper, colour some white paper blue

- * Silver foil
- * Scissors
- * Glue




- 1) Decided what you want your collage to look like, drawing your design on paper might be helpful.
- 2) Rip/cut blue, white paper and foil into small pieces.
- 3) Lay piece out on your design.
- 4) When you're happy with how it looks, glue in to place.

I made **Jack Frost**.

He's all blue, white and silvery because he's made from ice and has icicle hair. He's been making it very cold by sprinkling frost and snow everywhere.






