## ANIMAL ICE CREAM CONE DRAWING

These are ceramics pieces titled 'Melting Away’ by Emily Calcagno Chalco from St Patrick's Marist College. They are on exhibition at Goulburn Regional Art Gallery as part of the ARTEXPRESS 2020 exhibition.


We are going to draw animal ice cream scoops.


You will need:

* A piece of blank paper
* A pencil
* Crayons, pencils or textas for colouring
