<u>Fireman Song</u>


Fifty five firemen dressed in red

To and fro !!!












Cut along the flower stems






You will need:

A blank piece of paper Hungry Frog template Scissors Coloured pencils Glue




How to make a hungry frog



- Colour and cut out frog, also cut along dark line in frogs mouth
- Fold blank piece of paper in half
- Fold frog in half, coloured sides together
- Glue frog on to blank piece of paper (making sure you don't put glue on the frogs mouth) folded parts together
- Glue frog tongue in the frogs mouth
- Glue bugs around the frog
- Open and close to make the frog eat - yum yum






**Let's colour
