But only one little ducks came back


One little ducks went out one day . .














Cut along the dotted lines



Let's make

A Dancing Dragon



You will need:

Coloured paper Scissors Glue 2 straws



How to make your dragon


- Cut paper into strips, cut this shape on fold of paper for head, and cut 4 dragon claw shaped feet.
- Take one paper strip and glue ends together to make a ring, glue another strip through the first ring to make another and continue until your dragon paper-chain body is as long as you want.
- Draw face on dragon head, add a tongue or fire.
- Flatten one end of straw and glue to first ring and glue then head on also. Glue another straw to the last ring.
- I added some triangle pieces to make a tail.

** if you haven't got any coloured paper, just colour some plain paper the colours you want **











