

GOULBURN ART AWARD 2022

EXHIBITION 13 May – 18 June 2022

Opening and winners announcement 6pm Friday, 13 May

The Goulburn Art Award has been running since 1992 and is open to artists who live within a 120km radius of Goulburn. The award is designed to support artistic practices in the region and present the diversity and vibrancy of those practices to our audience. The award is open to works in any medium and in 2022 will be judged by Danny Lacy, Director, Mornington Peninsula Regional Gallery.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The Goulburn Art Award is open to artists living within a 120km radius of Goulburn CBD.
- 2. The Young Artist Award is open to Year 10, 11 and 2 students who attend a high school within a 120km radius of Goulburn CBD.
- 3. A non-refundable entry fee of \$25.00 applies.
- 4. No entry fee applies to the Young Artist Award.
- 5. All entered artwork must have been completed after April 2021 and be the original work of the artist.
- The online entry including completed entry form, images, CV, artist statement and entry fee must be received by 5pm Friday 1 April 2022.
- 7. Only one work can be submitted for consideration per artist
- 8. You must provide a high res image of the work to support your entry.
- Images must be high resolution JPEGs suitable for print and online but no larger than 5MB in total.
- 10. Image file names must include the artist's name and title of the artwork being submitted to the Award.
- 11. Due to space limitations, only finalists will be hung.
- 12. Two dimensional works must be no larger than 200 x 200cm including framing, and be fitted with two D rings, or other suitable hanging devices.

- 13. Three dimensional work must not exceed a volume of more than 100cm cubed and must not exceed more than 200cm in any direction.
- 14. Any work must not exceed 50 kilograms in weight.
- 15. Time based works must be submitted with a digital link provided to view and download of the entire work (maximum 10 mins length, MP4 files only, please provide a link to a highres version of your work).
- 16. Artworks that are not archival in nature will be assessed in addition to their suitability for display in a gallery environment (i.e. exposed botanical elements and untreated timbers).
- The work must be available to exhibit from 13 May – 18 June 2022.
- If selected as a finalist, work must be delivered to the Gallery during opening hours Mon – Fri 9am – 5pm 2 – 6 May 2022.
- 19. Work must be labelled with artists name title, year, medium and dimensions.
- 20. Work must be accompanied with installation instructions and all equipment necessary to display the work.
- If a finalist, work must be collected from the Gallery during opening hours Mon – Fri 9am – 5pm, 20 - 24 June 2022
- 22. The Winner will be contacted, as relevant, by the Gallery to fulfil their prize.
