### Indigenous Art with Amanda Reynolds

The goulburn.art Regional Gallery is hosting Amanda Reynolds, an independent curator, storyteller and creative artist, on the 26th and 27th of June for an after-hours talk, primary school visits and a community program.

Amanda is an independent curator, storyteller and creative artist who specialises in community-based collaborations; cultural healing and connection programs; and writing multi-voiced narratives for exhibitions, multimedia and publications.

On Monday 26th June Amanda will be presenting an after-hours talk centred on her creative community collaboration **Barangaroo Ngangamay** which was undertaken with Genevieve Grieves. The collaboration culminated in an augmented reality multimedia app which celebrates Aboriginal women's culture within the Sydney Region. Attendees are encouraged to download the free **Barangaroo Ngangamay** app at home before the talk and bring your smartphone or tablet along to experience a sample of the site-specific multimedia work. The talk will be held in the Council Chambers from 5:30pm – 7pm, and this is a free event.

On Tuesday 27th June members of the local Aboriginal community are invited to nurunyal-wali (possum armband) workshop where you will be guided in making an armband illustrating personal or community connection. This program is for Aboriginal people of all ages, but children do need adult supervision. It will be held from 5:30pm – 7pm in the Council Chambers, and is a free event.
