

GOULBURN YOUNG ARTIST AWARD 2024

The Goulburn Art Award has been running since 1992 and is open to artists who live within a 120km radius of Goulburn. The award is designed to support artistic practices in the region and present the diversity and vibrancy of those practices to our audience. The award is open to works in any medium. This is a non-acquisitive award and there are no thematic requirements for artworks entered in the award.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Young Artist Award is open students aged 10 -18 years, who attend a primary or high school within a 120km radius of Goulburn CBD. This includes the Southern Highlands, Yass, Canberra and Wollongong. Refer to <u>this map</u>.
- 2. Employees of the Goulburn Regional Art Gallery and Goulburn Mulwaree Council and their immediate families are ineligible to enter the competition. Immediate family means any of the following: child, stepchild, grandchild, niece, nephew, sibling, stepsibling or first cousin.
- 3. To be eligible, all entrants must a complete an entry form (below) and attach an image of the artwork and submit both by email by the due date.
- 4. No entry fee applies to the Young Artist Award.
- All entered artwork must have been completed in the last 12 months, between April 2023 and April 2024 and be the original work of the artist.
- 6. To enter you must complete all sections of the entry form, which includes a brief statement telling us about your artwork. This form must be signed by a legal parent or guardian. You must attach a high resolution JPEG image of your artwork (no more than 5MB). The entry form and JPEG must be submitted via email to Samantha Wiltshire, Education Officer, Goulburn Regional Art Gallery

- Entries must be received via email by 5pm Friday 5 April 2024.
- 8. Only one work can be submitted for consideration per artist.
- 9. Due to space limitations, only finalists will be displayed.
- Two-dimensional works must be no larger than 70 x 70cm including framing.

- 11. If selected as a finalist, the works must be prepared for display i.e. 2D works must be have D-latches or other appropriate hanging mechanism on the back to attach to wall and sculptural works must be able to be displayed on shelf or plinth as appropriate.
- 12. Three-dimensional work must not exceed more than 70cm in any direction.
- 13. Any work must not exceed 20 kilograms in weight.
- 14. Time based works must be submitted with a digital link provided to view and download of the entire work (maximum 5 mins length, MP4 files only, please provide a link to a high-res version of your work).
- 15. Artworks that are not archival in nature will be assessed in addition to their suitability for display in a gallery environment (i.e. exposed botanical elements and untreated timbers).
- If selected as a finalist, your artwork must be delivered to the Gallery during opening hours
 9am – 5pm Thursday 8 May 2024
- The work must be available to exhibit from 17 May – 22 June 2024.
- 18. Work must be labelled with artists name title, year, medium and dimensions.
- 19. If a finalist, work must be collected from the Gallery during opening hours 9am – 5pm, Tuesday 25 June 2024. Any Young Artist Award finalist work not collected will be disposed after 30 business days.
- 20. The Winner will be contacted, as relevant, by the Gallery to fulfil their prize.
- 21. By submitting an entry you agree to the terms and conditions stipulated.
